

By car from Bologna take the highway to Padova-Venezia, just before Venezia go left and proceed to Belluno, where the highway ends. After that go through the SS way in the direction of Cortina. 25 Km before Cortina you will arrive at Tai di Cadore, after that turn right to Nebbiù.

By train go to Calalzo station that is 3 km from Nebbiù. A taxi service is available.

## **CULTURE - SHOPPING - FUN - SPORT**

As well as Nebbiù can be considered the ideal archetype for people who love true mountains, you can do also something more.

At 3 Km away from Nebbiù there is Pieve di Cadore, that is the Main Town of the Magnificent Community of Cadore, where Tiziano Vecellio was born and where you can find his birthplace like it was in the XV century.

Pieve di Cadore overlooks its magnificent Lake, surrounded by woods which give a special colour to its waters.

In the Pieve di Cadore town center you can find a lot of shops, cafe and restaurants. Do not forget the outlets of eyeglasses, as the area is one of the biggest factory district in the world for that.

After that do not forget Cortina d'Ampezzo, the "Dolomites Pearl", with its magnificent valley, that is 27 km away from Nebbiù. Cortina has great social life, rich in cultural events, art galleries, gorgeous shops with unique and tipical items too, famous restaurants and meeting points of the international jet set.

The Cortina Ice Palace let you skate, see nice hockey games, look at figure skating shows. The same along the valley, the nearest Ice Palace is 3 km away from Nebbiù. In Cortina there is an impeccable service of Alpine Guides (the famous "Scoiattoli"), together with Ski Instructors. They make your vacation safer, helping you to understand and experience the mountains.

In Cortina there is a network with more than 120 km of beautiful ski slopes, with slopes suitable for every type of skier.

For cross-country skiing enthusiasts there are also tracks for all ages that branch off from Fiames and reach the Val Pusteria too.

## **SUMMER**

Nebbiù is surrounded by firs and larches woods, it faces on south, it is a mountain village with about 100 inhabitants, it is at the end of the road that goes up from the Valley that leads to Cortina d'Ampezzo, far from traffic, with its pure and fine air that, in the coldest months, mixes with the scent of wood burning in the chimneys. Nebbiù is the paradise for mushroom seekers.

The time here flows slowly, with a deafening silence, here we find the dimensions of a quiet life, broken only once a year by the traditional "Sagra" that (in the week of August) attracts festive people with music and dancing until late hours.

At the bottom of the valley (approx. 2 km) passes the Dolomites cycle path, which you can travel up to Austria and beyond, crossing Cortina, arriving in Val Pusteria and then towards Lienz along the Drava river.

If you prefer to put your backpack on your shoulder, Nebbiù is surrounded by beautiful landscapes with routes for all ages, with all kinds of difficulties, from the simplest and most flat routes to those reserved for the most experienced climbers: Monte Antelao, Sorapiss, Marmarole, the Pelmo, the Cristallo, the Faloria, the Tre Cime di Lavaredo, the Cadini di Misurina dominate on these paths of incomparable beauty, dotted with alpine shelters, precious destinations for rest and refreshment.



## **AUTUMN**

When autumn arrives, the larches are colored yellow and red in the midst of evergreen firs, the woods seem to catch fire and accompany, as in a single concert, the color of the dolomite rock that, from the top of the mountains and for a few minutes to sunset as always, it takes on a fiery red color ("enrosadira") and then resumes its natural pink color.

The usual mountain legends tell of good fairies and elves that populate the woods, who would find refuge among the hollows of the rocks near the Pissandro waterfalls, a few meters from the village, where the stream flows, which crosses Nebbiù with its crystal clear waters descending from Mount Antelao.

This is also a paradise for those who love photography, with landscapes with the most fantastic perspectives, with colors and transparencies that inspire every imagination.

Here in autumn the silence becomes even more silent, giving more and more space to contemplation and meditation, to good reading, to the last walks with your summer boots, before winter arrives with its healthy cold and snow.



## WINTER

With the cold the snow arrives and the great skiing party begins (downhill and cross-country). The large ski areas of Cortina d'Ampezzo as far as the Alta Val Badia, Auronzo di Cadore are just a few kilometers away. Put your skis in your car or use the ski buses that depart from Tai di Cadore (3 Km from Nebbiù) and set off towards tracks and paths of every difficulty, which satisfy children and great experts.

Or, if you prefer more secluded paths, put the snowshoes on your feet (the "ciaspe") and go for a walk on the fresh snow, among woods and paths.

Even in winter the mountain huts welcome you to make your days more pleasant, shelter from the cold or offer you balconies on majestic landscapes, where you can sunbathe. Typical foods and drinks help you to refresh and recharge your batteries (like not thinking about the excellent Kaiser Schmarren or the bombardino?).

And if the snow covers the house, here is another beautiful sport to do: shovel the snow! Excellent gymnastics and, if you do it at sunset, you will be enchanted by the muffled sounds of those who like you, from the lights that begin to light up in the houses, from the smoke that comes out of the chimneys with that magical smell of burning wood. But if you are a little tired or lazy, don't worry, you will always find someone ready to "shovel" for you with a small tip.
