More than one year has elapsed since the onset of COVID-19 pandemic, the darkest period of the Italian history after the last war, during which professional upgrade in healthcare and particularly surgical training faced an unprecedented setback.

The Italy Chapter of the American College of Surgeons has decided to welcome the revival of face-to-face congress activity by organizing its National Congress in Catania on 1 and 2 July 2021.

The Congress will allow scholars of the major surgical themes to resume the debate they had to suspend due to the pandemic and, given the chosen period, it will probably be among the very first face-to-face surgical meetings. I believe we all wish to give a boost to professional education and upgrade, especially now that the Covid-19 infection seems to be really under control and we all feel more confident about life going back to normal.

The Congress will be preceded by a "Surgical Education course" reserved to a limited number of practicing surgeons who will be able to experiment the use of advanced surgical simulators in order to assess their manual dexterity.

The Scientific Program is focused on the most recent specialties of General Surgery with the participation of outstanding experts, both national and international; which will give our Italian fellow colleagues the opportunity to be updated on the latest innovations and insights into conventional as well as minimally invasive and robotic surgery. The following surgical specialties will be addressed: gastric esophageal surgery, oncologic surgery, colorectal surgery, bariatric surgery, hepato-bilio-pancreatic surgery, abdominal wall surgery. A session on oncologic surgery will also be attended by some governors of the European Region 15, while a joint session with the Italian Society for Surgical Endoscopy will be devoted to the impact of COVID-19 on surgical activity with a particular focus on training.

Major technological breakthroughs and the advancement in surgical science over the last decade together with the vision of an accurate and assertive surgeon capable of achieving the best results for his patients, are the leit motif of the Congress.

It is my honour to organise this National Congress and I'm looking forward to meeting you all in Catania.

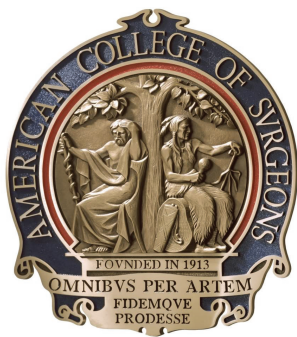
